Ravenswood Family Health Center is committed to provide the highest quality primary health services, delivered in a competent, caring, and culturally sensitive manner, regardless of ability to pay.

RFHC is the only federally funded nonprofit community health center in San Mateo County. The clinic offers full scope primary medical care and prevention services to underserved and uninsured ethnic minorities and low-income families. Over 15,300 people have enrolled as patients since the clinic opened in December 2001.

Community partnerships are vitally important to RFHC. The clinic works in close collaboration with Lucile Packard Children's Hospital, Palo Alto Medical Foundation, and others to expand its capacity, referral system, and collaborative health awareness efforts.
