Ravenswood Family Health Center is working to enhance integration of services between our pediatric primary care program and dental practice.

The Pediatric Dental Health Navigator Intern serves as a link for families by providing navigation and warm hand-offs between our pediatric primary medical program and dental clinic. Under the direction of the Volunteer Coordinator, day-to-day learning opportunities will include any or all of the following activities:

- Escorting families between RFHC medical and dental facilities
- Facilitating a warm hand-off for patients between pediatric providers and dental staff
- Conducting patient follow-up
- Working with families to promote access to oral health care
- Creating informational dental materials for parents and children
- Developing and implementing pediatric dental marketing/promotion strategies
- Providing targeted oral health education in the dental clinic exam room
- Conducting ongoing assessments of the referral and warm-handoff process
- Assisting dental, medical and/or enrollment staff to conduct patient dental screening and referrals

The ideal candidate will be a highly professional team player with a passion for community health.

- Spanish or Tongan fluency strongly preferred
- Background in health and/or oral health highly desirable

Time commitment: 12-16 hours per week for a minimum of 4 months.
